| <p>My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense—Jesus Christ, the Righteous One.</p> <p>² He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world.</p> <p>³ We know that we have come to know him if we obey his commands.</p> <p>⁴ The man who says, “I know him,” but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in him.</p> | <p>¹ My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:</p> <p>² And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for <i>the sins of</i> the whole world.</p> <p>³ And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.</p> <p>⁴ He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.</p> | | | |

| <p>⁵ But if anyone obeys his word, God's love is truly made complete in him. This is how we know we are in him:</p> <p>⁶ Whoever claims to live in him must walk as Jesus did.</p> <p>⁷ Dear friends, I am not writing you a new command but an old one, which you have had since the beginning. This old command is the message you have heard.</p> <p>⁸ Yet I am writing you a new command; its truth is seen in him and you, because the darkness is passing and the true light is already shining.</p> | <p>⁵ But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him.</p> <p>⁶ He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.</p> <p>⁷ Brethren, I write no new commandment unto you, but an old commandment which ye had from the beginning. | <p>⁹ Anyone who claims to be in the light but hates his brother is still in the darkness.</p> <p>¹⁰ Whoever loves his brother lives in the light, and there is nothing in him to make him stumble.</p> <p>¹¹ But whoever hates his brother is in the darkness and walks around in the darkness; he does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded him.</p> | <p>⁹ He that saith he is in the light, and hateth his brother, is in darkness even until now.</p> <p>¹⁰ He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him.</p> <p>¹¹ But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes.</p> | | | |

| <p>¹⁵ Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.</p> <p>¹⁶ For everything in the world—the cravings of sinful man, the lust of his eyes and the boasting of what he has and does—comes not from the Father but from the world.</p> <p>¹⁷ The world and its desires pass away, but the man who does the will of God lives forever.</p> | <p>¹⁵ Love not the world, neither the things <i>that are</i> in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.</p> <p>¹⁶ For all that <i>is</i> in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.</p> <p>¹⁷ And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.</p> | | | |

| <p>¹⁸ Dear children, this is the last hour; and as you have heard that the antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have come. This is how we know it is the last hour.</p> <p>¹⁹ They went out from us, but they did not really belong to us. For if they had belonged to us, they would have remained with us; but their going showed that none of them belonged to us.</p> <p>²⁰ But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and all of you know the truth.</p> <p>²¹ I do not write to you because you do not know the truth, but because you do know it and because no lie comes from the truth.</p> | <p>¹⁸ Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time.</p> <p>¹⁹ They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would <i>no doubt</i> have continued with us: but <i>they went out</i>, that they might be made manifest that they were not all of us.</p> <p>²⁰ But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things.</p> <p>²¹ I have not written unto you because ye know not the truth, but because ye know it, and that no lie is of the truth.</p> | | | |

| <p>²² Who is the liar? It is the man who denies that Jesus is the Christ. Such a man is the antichrist—he denies the Father and the Son.</p> <p>²³ No one who denies the Son has the Father; whoever acknowledges the Son has the Father also.</p> <p>²⁴ See that what you have heard from the beginning remains in you. If it does, you also will remain in the Son and in the Father.</p> <p>²⁵ And this is what he promised us—even eternal life.</p> <p>²⁶ I am writing these things to you about those who are trying to lead you astray.</p> | <p>²² Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.</p> <p>²³ Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: <i>(but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.</i></p> <p>²⁴ Let that therefore abide in you, which ye have heard from the beginning. If that which ye have heard from the beginning shall remain in you, ye also shall continue in the Son, and in the Father.</p> <p>²⁵ And this is the promise that he hath promised us, <i>even</i> eternal life.</p> <p>²⁶ These <i>things</i> have I written unto you concerning them that seduce you.</p> | | | |

| <p>²⁷ As for you, the anointing you received from him remains in you, and you do not need anyone to teach you. But as his anointing teaches you about all things and as that anointing is real, not counterfeit—just as it has taught you, remain in him.</p> <p>²⁸ And now, dear children, continue in him, so that when he appears we may be confident and unashamed before him at his coming.</p> <p>²⁹ If you know that he is righteous, you know that everyone who does what is right has been born of him.</p> | <p>²⁷ But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.</p> <p>²⁸ And now, little children, abide in him; that, when he shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be ashamed before him at his coming.</p> <p>²⁹ If ye know that he is righteous, ye know that every one that doeth righteousness is born of him.</p> | | | |
